<p><u>Shape hunt</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go on a shape hunt around your house and draw any you find. 2. Can you describe what they look like and sort them into sets-you might put all of the shapes with curved edges together and all of the shapes with straight sides together. 3 .Can you count the corners? 4. Can you draw a shape picture? 	<p>Look for words around your house - they might be on letters or on food packets, on reading books or on the television control. How many words can you find? When you have found them spot any sounds you know and practise reading them -</p> <p>Read any of your books with a grown up and find any words and sounds you know.</p>	<p>Practise writing short sentences - use your 'fred' fingers to sound out. Practise using the tricky word my and like in your sentences this week e.g.</p> <p>I like my cat I like to run and hop I like to run and jump</p> <p>you can mark your work and show your grown up how we put a tick for each sound we do and use our finger spaces</p>	<p>Practise writing your letters from the caterpillar family. Each letter goes around the caterpillar first. By the last day you will be perfect. We can't wait to see your beautiful handwriting.</p>
