We are looking at suffixes again this week. Remember a suffix is a group of letters that are added to the end of a word to change its meaning.

## Writing

When you write your story, remember to think about spelling, full stops and capital letters and handwriting.

Could you also add some exciting sentence openers, like 'Just then' or 'Suddenly' or extend your sentences by using words such as 'but' or 'because'?
